Stop Signs and Bus Stops

We are still receiving complaints regarding vehicles not stopping at stop signs, driving past stopped buses and general speeding through the neighborhood.

We have many of our residents who park too close to the intersection (law says you cannot park within 25 feet of an intersection), whether they are waiting for a bus or not. This limits our visibility around corners and brings concerns for safety for our children while waiting for the bus.

Please use extra caution when driving through our neighborhood, slow down, take your time.

Ways to Keep the Neighborhood Clean and Safe

1. Curb your dog. As you are walking your dog, and nature calls, keep them on the strip of grass closest to the curb, as dog waste tends to damage grass and shrubbery. Remember to keep a plastic bag with you on walks to clean up any droppings.
2. Please pick up any trash throughout the neighborhood.
3. County Code does not allow excessive dog barking, even during the day. If you hear a dog that is left outside all day while the owner is (or is not) home, you can report the violation anonymously to NCC Code Violations at 395-5555. County Noise Ordinance is **10pm– 7am**. Please remember this when you let your dogs out at night as well as driving through the neighborhood with loud music.
4. NCC Code states that company vehicles are not allowed to be permanently parked in the neighborhood. If you have a logoed vehicle, it must stay at your place of employment
