Ways to Keep the Neighborhood Clean and Safe

1. Curb your dog. As you are walking your dog, and nature calls, keep them on the strip of grass closest to the curb, as dog waste tends to damage grass and shrubbery. Remember to keep a plastic bag with you on walks to clean up any droppings.
2. Please pick up any trash throughout the neighborhood. If you don't read the "Community News" then please put it in the recycling bin instead of leaving it on the sidewalk.
3. County Code does not allow dogs unattended outside for extended periods of the day. If you see or hear a dog that is left outside all day while the owner is (or is not home), you can report the violation anonymously to NCC Code Violations at 395-5555. County Noise Ordinance is **10pm– 7am**. Please remember this when you let your dogs out as well as driving through the neighborhood with loud music.
4. NCC Code states that company vehicles are not allowed in the neighborhood. If you have a logeod vehicle, it must stay at your place of employment
